Location: Lytle Creek Range, Lytle Creek, CA

The Center Fire Rifle Shoot competition will consist of 20-plus rounds. Iron sights only, no .22s and nothing larger than .45 caliber. The Center Fire Pistol Shoot will consist of 50 rounds. Iron sights only. Nothing smaller than .25 caliber and nothing larger than .45 caliber. Two hands OK. Safety strap OK. Arms must be held free of body. Hands and arms free of support. Adaptive equipment may be allowed but must be approved for safety reasons by the tournament director and the national PVA Shooting Sports director. The pistol shoot is open to the first 25 people that register. New ammunition only, no reloads. Ammunition will be provided for shooters who preregister and indicate the caliber of their pistol on their preregistration form. Spotting scopes encouraged. Awards will be presented at the Sunday evening awards banquet: Champion and Runner-up.

Slow fire at the 15-yard line. 10 rounds in 10 minutes.

Awards will be presented Sunday.

The Center Fire Rifle Shoot competition will consist of 20-plus rounds. Iron sights only, nothing smaller than .32 caliber and nothing larger than .45 caliber. Rifle must conform to state laws. Shooting will be in the prone and standing positions. Slings and shooting jackets allowed, and encouraged, for all shooters in both positions. New ammunition only, no reloads. Ammunition will be provided for shooters who preregister and indicate the caliber of their rifle on their preregistration form. Spotting scopes encouraged. Awards will be presented at the Sunday evening awards banquet: Champion and Runner-up.

In the prone position the able-bodied shooter will lay on the ground, mat allowed. The disabled shooter will sit at a table with both elbows and chest allowed to rest on the table. Table may be freestanding or attached to the wheelchair. Other adaptive equipment may be allowed but must be approved for safety reasons by the tournament director and the PVA Shooting Sports director.

In the standing position the able-bodied shooter will stand with no support. The disabled will sit in an upright position, with safety strap allowed. Other adaptive equipment may be allowed but must be approved for safety reasons by the tournament director and the PVA Shooting Sports director.

Prep Time:

Ten minutes for set-up and sighting shots, if needed, at the 100-yard line, prone or standing, shooters provide own ammunition.

Competition:

Slow Fire, prone position, at the 100-yard line, 5 rounds in 7 minutes.

Timed Fire, prone position, at the 100-yard line, 5 rounds in 1 minute.

Slow Fire, standing position, at the 100-yard line, 5 rounds in 7 minutes.

Timed Fire, standing position, at the 100-yard line, 5 rounds in 1 minute.

Individual Awards:

Grand Champion:

Based on 300 targets for both days' combined events.

Wheelchair Champion:

Based on 300 targets for both days' combined events.

Short (19–21), Mid (22–24), and Long (25–27) Champion:

Each day, Saturday and Sunday.

Singles Champion in each class:

AA–D Each day, Saturday and Sunday

Doubles Champion in each class:

AA–D Each day, Saturday and Sunday

Wagon Wheel Champion:

Saturday and Sunday

Chapter Team Awards:

Champion and Runner-up Chapter team awards will be given to the top two chapter teams based on all 300 targets. To qualify, the team must be constituted in accordance with the PVA Trap Circuit rules for chapter teams. Team captain's scores will be used to determine the winners in the event of a tie.

Squad Requests:

We will honor all squad requests for the singles and doubles events that are recorded on your entry form when you preregister. We will "re-squad" for the handicap event based upon your handicap yardage. Squads will be assigned when no preference is reported on your registration form.

Emergency Procedures:

In the event of an emergency, the tournament director and the national PVA representative will be notified. In the event of a personal injury of a serious nature, call 911. Entry Fee & Meals:

The entry fee is \$90 per day. The fee includes the welcome reception on Friday, and breakfast, lunch, targets, and ammunition for competition (50 singles, 50 handicap, 25 pair doubles, plus 25 Wagon Wheel) for each day that you register plus the Sunday Awards Banquet for those who shoot both days and make reservations for the Awards Banquet by March 28, 2012. The Wagon Wheel is 25 trap targets shot from the 8 skeet positions, 3 targets at each station with an optional shot when the first target is missed or at the end. Please send your complete entry form, along with your payment to Cal-Diego PVA, 3350 La Jolla Village Drive, Room #1A-118, San Diego, CA 92161.

Refunds will be made in emergency situations only.

The deadline for hotel reservations is March 22, and the deadline for awards banquet reservations is March 28. There is no deadline to register for the competition. This is a fundraising event for Cal-Diego PVA. Any additional funds raised will be used to support the Cal-Diego Trap Program as well as other chapter programs.

Transportation:

Transportation between the Ontario International Airport and the San Bernardino Hilton Hotel is available for \$25 per person if it is requested when pre-registering, and the fee is included with the entry form. Transportation will be provided at no charge, for participants and their guests, between the San Bernardino Hilton Hotel and the trap range for the Friday afternoon practice and for each day's competitions.

Accommodations:

Participants must make their own reservations at the San Bernardino Hilton Hotel located at 285 East Hospitality Lane, San Bernardino, CA 92408, 909-889-0133 or 800-HILTONS. The deadline for hotel reservations at \$84 plus tax at approx 10% (\$94) is March 22 or when the 40 blocked rooms have been reserved. Reserve early!

Equipment/Shells:

Shotguns, pouches, and earplugs will be provided for those who request them on the entry form. Shells will be available for purchase for the fun shoots and practice.

Rules & Range Safety:

Modified ATA rules will apply. PVA's modifications will be posted at the range. They are available for viewing at www.pva.org. Decisions by shoot officials are final. Safety is of paramount importance. Safety rules are posted at the range. Participants may not consume alcoholic beverages until they have finished shooting for the day. Infractions will be cause for immediate disqualification.

Directions:

Airport to Hotel: Take San Bernardino Freeway (Route 10) east, about 30 miles to the Waterman Ave. exit. Turn left on Waterman and then left on E. Hospitality Lane; the San Bernardino Hilton is on the left at 285 E. Hospitality Lane.

Hotel to Trap Range: Exit parking lot and turn right on E. Hospitality Lane. Turn right on S. Waterman Ave. then right onto I-10 East (San Bernardino Freeway) on-ramp. Take freeway east to Orange St. exit. Go through stop sign; at the traffic light, turn left onto Orange St. Proceed 1.5 miles to the Redlands Shooting Park, 2125 N. Orange St., Redlands, CA 92374, 909-335-8844, www.redlandsshootingpark.com.

Hotel to Pistol and Rifle Range: Exit Hilton parking lot and turn right on E. Hospitality Lane. Turn right on S. Waterman Ave. and then right onto I-215N toward San Bernardino/Barstow. Go 14 miles and take the off-ramp for I-15S. Go 3 miles and take the off-ramp for Sierra Ave; turn right on Sierra Ave (it becomes Lytle Creek Rd). When pavement ends (11 miles) turn into the range parking lot. 951-782-7438.

Options:

Options are a form of speculation, and they are entirely optional. Cal-Diego PVA will receive 25 percent of all options except the two \$2,500 jackpots. On all options, ties are divided using percentages.

The \$5,000 Jackpot Options:

These two \$2,500 options are based on the 150 targets for each day's shooting (not counting the Wagon Wheel Event). Each shooter is eligible to compete for these jackpots by donating \$20 for each. The winner will be chosen by a five-class Lewis System. The \$5,000 was donated anonymously.



The Calcutta Option:

This is a separate option based on each day's 50 handicap targets. Shooters wanting to participate in the Calcutta register by paying \$10. Bidding for those shooters will commence at 9:15 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday at the Range Club House. Anyone can bid; minimum bid is \$10. The highest bidder wins the shooter. Any shooter who is not bought agrees to pay \$10 as purchaser. The \$10 paid by the shooter and the total amount bid for each shooter will be the Calcutta pot. There are four prizes: 50 percent, 25 percent, 15 percent, and 10 percent, with 60 percent going to the bidder and 40 percent to the shooter.



The Silent Partner Options:

These are available as separate events on both Saturday and Sunday and are based on each day's combined singles, doubles, and handicap targets. Shooters pay \$10 to participate in each day's option. Two participants' names are randomly drawn to form a partnership of two shooters. Total scores on all 150 targets by each partner are added to determine the winner of the Silent Partner pot. There are four prizes: 50 percent, 25 percent, 15 percent, and 10 percent.

Lewis Class Purse Options:

There will be a three-class Lewis Purse on singles, handicap, and doubles on both Saturday and Sunday. Cost to enter is \$10 each day.



Class Purse Options, Single and Doubles:

On both Saturday and Sunday, there will be class purses for singles and doubles. The entry fee is \$10 each day. Money will be paid out for every seven participants in a class. Money will be refunded for all classes with fewer than three participants.

Handicap 25s Options:

There will be a handicap 25s purse on both Saturday and Sunday. Cost to enter is \$10 each day.
